Upon online registration and payment via credit card, you have access to the EuCOMC 2017 conference. Please note that you have the right to cancel your participation within 7 working days after your online payment without giving any reason and without penalty.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Should you be unable to attend the EuCOMC 2017 conference, a substitute may attend in your place.

If a cancellation is received before the **April 30, 2017**, only a 20% processing fee will be incurred. Upon cancellation before **May 31, 2017**, 50% of the fee will be refunded. After **June 1 2017**, no refund will be possible.

All refunds will be made after the conference.

EuCOMC 2017 shall not be liable for any damages of any kind, including indirect, consequential or incidental damages arising from or relating to the attending of the conference.
